LIGHT IN THE ANDES

This month has felt full of little glimpses of God’s light breaking through – in the prayer room, on the streets, in the middle of challenges, and in hearts being awakened to Jesus across the Andes.

Light in the Andes Festival

Last month we had the absolute joy of being invited back to create a 24-7 prayer space at the incredible Light in the Andes Festival – a Christian festival right in the heart of the Andes Mountains. And wow... what a few days it was.

More than 2,000 young people stepped into the prayer space to encounter the living Jesus. The atmosphere was full of hunger, healing, freedom, and the tangible presence of God. Lives were marked, hearts awakened, and young people responded so beautifully to Him.

Our prayer throughout the festival was simple: that every person who entered the prayer room would encounter God’s presence, have their hearts set ablaze, and leave carrying the light of Christ wherever they go. And honestly... we watched God do exactly that.

One story we’d love to share with you from the festival is this...

A young guy, around 17 years old, felt the Holy Spirit gently prompt him to pray for an older lady sitting in the prayer tent. He sensed God say, “Put your hand on her back.”

Not knowing her at all, he simply stepped out in faith and did exactly that. The lady immediately felt an intense warmth spread across her back. She later shared that she had suffered with back pain for years - but in that moment, in the prayer tent, the pain completely left her. With tears rolling down her face, she declared that Jesus had healed her.



STREET PRAYER

Wednesday afternoons have become one of our favourite parts of the week because around here, Wednesdays mean one thing... street prayer time! The team keeps growing, and so do the number of hearts being awakened by the love of Jesus.

Some weeks are quiet and gentle, other weeks are full-on adventure mode, but every single week, we see God moving in beautiful ways.

This past week, during one of our regular visits to the market, we noticed something really special happening. Because we've been consistently showing up, relationships and trust have started to grow. People who once only watched from a distance, this week began to open up and ask questions – not out of politeness, but from genuine hunger. People were asking things like, "How do I pray?" and "How can I talk to God?"

For many of them, it was the first time they had ever felt comfortable enough to ask those questions and it deeply encouraged our whole team who have been praying for the light of Jesus to breakthrough the darkness, hopelessness and despair felt in the lives of people in this market.

It was such a powerful reminder that ministry often begins long before the big moments. It starts with simply showing up consistently, loving people well, building trust, and quietly carrying the light of Jesus into everyday places.



RETREAT CENTRE UPDATE

It's all hands on deck as we race towards finishing the 24-7 Prayer Perú Retreat Centre, ready to welcome our first team of the year next week! There's been many coffee-fuelled late nights... and plenty of moments where everyone has simply jumped in wherever needed. We're so excited to fill this place with teams, volunteers, and individuals seeking God. We're so grateful for every single person who has prayed for us, encouraged us, and stood with us. Thank you for continuing to cover us in prayer – it means more than we can say.
